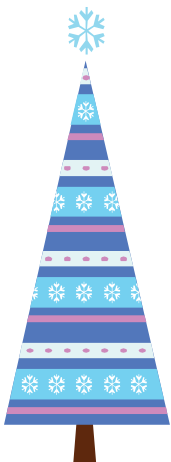
Olympic Torch in Saskatoon!
