The recycling program is scheduled to take effect in January of 2013. This means that the recycling bins will be delivered to your home at some point after January with pickup to commence two weeks later. Once your bin has been received, you will be charged \$4.66 per month on your utility bill.

Infrastructure:

The issue that was most discussed on the doorsteps of every Ward was the state of our infrastructure. As a result, City Council will be determining the best course of action to adequately fund our roads and bridges. You may see a number of news articles regarding this, but nothing has been finalized at this time.

Traffic Flow:

A number of questions were received about the traffic flow in and out of Fairhaven.

- Clancy Drive has still not been reopened. The early snowfall has hampered the completion of the changes to be made to Clancy Drive.
- Fairmont Drive exit onto 22nd Street has just been narrowed to one lane. This was always the intent of this off-ramp; however, motorists were using it as two and sometimes three lanes. This was extremely dangerous and did not help with the flow of traffic. There are plans to close off the access to Confederation Drive from this off-ramp in the spring so that vehicles will not continue to wait for all lanes of 22nd Street to be clear before making their way onto 22nd Street. The intent of this exit is to provide access to Circle Drive. Motorists wishing to utilize 22nd Street or Confederation Drive should be using the Fairlight and Diefenbaker exit.
- I am in discussions with the Traffic Branch to work on a solution that will ease traffic flow in and out of this area.
