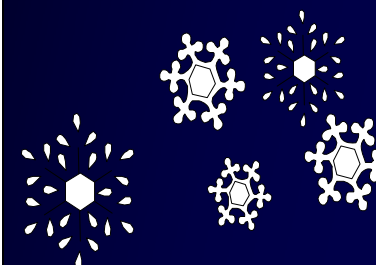

The Flag and Our Community

In 1964, Prime Minister Lester B. Pearson appointed a committee to resolve the issue, sparking a serious debate about a flag change. Out of three choices, the maple leaf design by George F. G. Stanley and John Matheson based on the flag of the Royal Military College of Canada was selected. The flag made its first appearance on February 15, 1965; the date is now celebrated annually as National Flag of Canada Day.

Many different flags have been created for use by Canadian officials, government bodies, and military forces. Most of these flags contain the maple leaf motif in some fashion, either by having the Canadian flag charged in the canton, or by including maple leaves in the design. {Wikipedia}

PHCA's logo includes the Canadian Flag to reflect one of our schools being named after LB.Pearson.

Ward 3 and City News

Spring is on the horizon and we have had a mild winter, so it might seem odd to be discussing snow removal. However, I recently submitted an enquiry to the Administration to find out what the cost would be of implementing a residential snow program for 2013. I submitted the enquiry because many residents in Ward 3 have complained about the road conditions on residential streets during normal winter weather conditions. We have now received a report, which indicates a small increase to the mill rate would be required, and we will be debating it during the next budget cycle (December, 2012).

Retail businesses are looking at the Confederation and Blairmore areas with interest. In addition to the former Canadian Tire being leased to retail stores, I am currently working with a developer to bring a large retail outlet into the Blairmore area. Hopefully, we will be able to attract some restaurants as well, as that is desperately needed in our area.

Approximately 80 people attended the Kensington Open House in January. Of those who attended, I have heard mixed comments about the proposed development. While the new neighbourhoods cannot be closed off from existing neighbourhoods, we still need to ensure safety is paramount on our streets. I lived on Cockburn Crescent for many years, and know firsthand how difficult the road

conditions on Centennial Drive can be. I am hopeful the Administration's plan for Centennial Drive will meet the needs of the residents, and still allow Kensington to be a part of the community.
