- Pacific Heights Community Association honors other community association memberships.


CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

- Refunds for those who wish to quit a program will ONLY be issued if the Inside Programs Coordinator is contacted 24 hours prior to the second class.


COST-AS-BARRIER POLICY


